God has blessed us with a loyal and Godly senior staff whose hearts are so full of love for God and the children that even when things get tough (and they often do), they reassure me that they are not going anywhere!

Allen returned recently from New York City where he completed a six-week-course in English, compliments of a scholarship from the university he is attending. He is working toward a degree in law. Allen grew up in Hogar Del Rey and calls it home. He lives there and helps in the office and around the house when he is not busy with classes.

Yani, also 20, lives in the children's home, attends the university, and is working toward earning the same degree Allen is persuing. She entered Hogar Del Rey when she was very young. She helps to care for the younger children as her schedule and studies permit.

As promised, I received an estimate for the needed repairs in the bathrooms at Casa Del Rey, the girls' home in El Moral. The estimate is only \$1000. I could withdraw this amount from the general fund; however, doing so would result in a budget shortfall and we possibly would be addressing only a few of the serious plumbing problems that we know about, not to mention the surprises that arise once the project begins!
