Hello Brethren, I hope you are doing well this morning, in this picture we are at the desert project in the village of Jaboncillos Chico and meeting to their basic needs and much needed school supplies. I have been meaning to send this off but there is always something coming up. The specific needs that we have are for the elementary school age children in the 3 ongoing projects that we have currently. What we are asking for is elementary school supplies for children, we give the teachers the supplies so they can hand out to the need of each child in his or her classroom. This works well in this area as well as the desert project however, in the Chiapas project it is very costly sending school supplies, we usually send available funds so they can be purchased there proximal the area of they are working at.

Supplies such as scissors, bottle and stick glue, composition and spiral notebooks, pencils, pens, crayons, Crayola markers, rulers, erasers, construction paper, small inexpensive backpacks.

Throughout the year we purchase these items at discounted prices after the rush of starting school. We then store them for this present time however we seem to have a greater need as well as the added project in the desert area.

In the Allende project we estimate approx. 150 children with basic supply needs and we will only be sharing with those children in attendance at Vacation Bible school on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of this month.

In the desert project we already have the figure, 97 children have the need of school supplies in 3 elementary schools. This is the area of most need because of the lack of income, no work. In this project we are in the process of creating small family garden plots as well as a community greenhouse garden for each of the 3 villages. This project is primarily for children and their nutritional needs, as well as for the entire family.

In the Chiapas project, we have several projects at the same time:

- 1. Medical missionary training to several adult indigenous groups.
- 2. Childrens medical cadet program to continue their training.
- 3. Small plot gardening for families at several locations.
- 4. Building and construction to designated church or another project.
- 5. Evangelism in other communities.
- 6. Childrens school supply needs, this need is most crucial, even though school at this age is mandatory, if they do not have access to these needs, children fall through the cracks, stay behind, and become part of the vicious cycle of the poor work force.
