

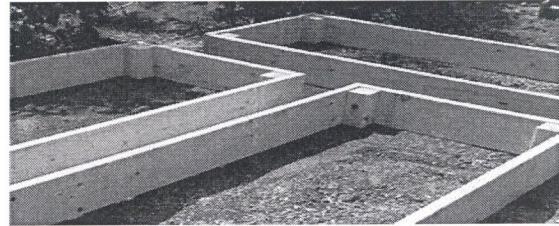
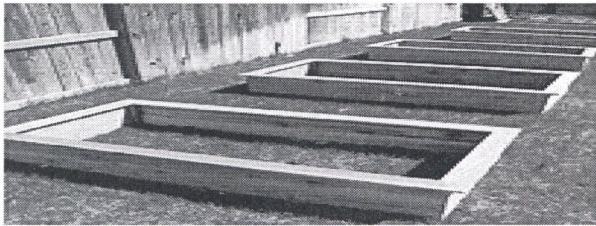

Ocampo Desert Project

November 25, 2023

Hello brethren, this is a short newsletter indicating what we hope to be doing till the new year. We will be going to the desert project this week; we hope to be installing small 4x4 wooden raised beds for planting and getting them ready for spring planting of vegetables. In the meantime, we hope to plant garlic and onions and other winter vegetables. We will be taking some blankets and winter clothing for the children and taking some staple foods such as rice, beans, oatmeal, juices, and some canned foods for families in Jaboncillos Chico, Piedritas, San Vicente, La Union, El Milagro, and San Miguel. We will also continue with the health lectures and teachings to the children through the Childrens Evangelistic Fellowship project. Please pray for the continued success of this desert project. If you have any extra blankets or winter clothing for children or extra food staples it would be greatly appreciated.



Childrens Health Cadet Project

Last week we sent another shipment of Bibles to the state of Tabasco for the Pastors that will be taking the health training this next March 2024. We will be sending childrens illustrated bibles this coming week and be sending 15 cases of bibles to the Shekhinah Institute in Palenque Chiapas. The director of this institute has asked us to consider having health missionary training year-round and has mentioned the possibility of handing over the directorship to the Harvest Health Ministry. He is not doing well health wise, and he will be stepping down. We also intend to create a missionary training program year-round at Sidon Tiakil and eventually train some brothers from Guatemala and southward. We will be sending childrens bibles for the cadets to share with their age groups as they spread the health message and the salvation message.

H.O.P.E. Migrant Childrens Project

The city and state government has requested we assist them in housing and feeding migrants as the winter approaches. **In Mexico, a request is not negotiable**, however we will only help husband/wife with children. No singles. We will be sharing Jesus with the families and hand out childrens bibles and share the **Children Fellowship Program** with them. I have often mentioned that action speaks louder than words, and by this I hope to share the good news of Jesus through faith in action,

Mathew 25: 34-40 speaks about this:

“Then the King will say to them on His right hand, ‘Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I *was* naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.’ “Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, ‘Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed *You*, or thirsty and give *You* drink? When did we see You a stranger and take *You* in, or naked and clothe *You*? Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?’ And the King will answer and say to them, ‘Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did *it* to one of the least of these My brethren, you did *it* to Me.’
